

Festival Year: 55

The Bristol Mum Festival is an annual festival which includes the Mum Parade. The festival celebrates chrysanthemums, formerly a major product of the town, and was first held on Sunday, October 7, 1962. In 2015, the dedicated volunteer organization had decided to disband, and thanks to the Exchange Club of Bristol Connecticut Incorporated, and the City of Bristol, the historic festival continued. In 2016, the festival was renamed the Bristol Mum Festival, and is directed by the Bristol Exchange Club, and its main benefactor is the City of Bristol. The festival is also supported by several generous sponsors. The new organization had restored many of the original components, like four full days of festivities, which included the Mum Parade, return of the Miss Mum Pageant, Art Show, return of the vendor fair, food & truck fest, Adult Beverage Garden, Kid's Depot, Car Show, Horse and Hay Rides, Movie night, Fireworks, Mumathon Road Race, and several other great activities.

In 2015, Mayor Ken Cockayne had called a meeting with John (Jack) Ferraro, of the Exchange Club of Bristol, to figure out the fate of the Mum Festival Parade, which the city funded through a special \$15K Grant. The Exchange Club had produced the Mum Parade for over 50 years for the City of Bristol and had agreed to continue to run it for the city. The mayor asked Jack Ferraro and Don Soucy if the Exchange Club might be interested in also running the Mum Festival. The Mayor and Board of Finance agreed to fund a portion of the festival, providing a \$35K Grant, which represented a third of the Mum Festival's actual cost, which did not include the Mum Parade. The Exchange Club was tasked with raising the other funds needed. A proposal was made to the Exchange Club's Board of Directors, and it was voted on that they would take on the historic Mum Festival. The Chamber of Commerce agreed to assist the Exchange Club with the festival for the first year, and allowed their Marketing Manager, Mark Walerysiak Jr. to serve as Chair, along with Jack Ferraro. The first year was a huge success and has been ever since. It was recorded as one of the largest festivals on records!
